EACH DAY...

- Pray that God would help you to understand the passage, and learn new things.
- Read the passage.
- Go through the questions (you might like to write down your answers)
- Pray in response to what you have learnt and been challenged about.

SATURDAY

Mark 14:32-36

1. What is it that Jesus is distressed and troubled about? (Think back to the start of Chapter 14 if you are not sure).
2. How does Jesus respond to the anxious situation he finds himself in?
3. Think - Do your prayers in time of need have the same characteristics of that which Jesus prays?

SUNDAY

Mark 14:37-42

1. What do these verses teach us about the importance of prayer?
2. Why do you think the disciples were not ready for what was about to happen in the same way that Jesus was?
3. Think - In what ways do you sometimes find yourself 'napping' when it comes to doing what Jesus calls you to do?

MONDAY

Mark 14:43-52

1. How does this sequence of events 'fulfil Scripture'? (Hint - look at Isaiah 53:7-9)
2. Think - What confidence can you have from knowing that Jesus fulfils everything that is promised about him?

TUESDAY

Review – Chapter 14:26-52

1. In what ways is Jesus calm and confident in this section in the midst of what should be distressing times for him?
2. For what reasons and in what ways does Jesus maintain his calm?
3. Think - What can you learn about responding to tough situations from Jesus' example?

WEDNESDAY

Mark 14:53-59

1. What kind of impression is given here of those who are looking to put Jesus to death?
2. To what do you think Jesus was referring in verse 58? (See also John 2:19)
3. Think - How does this passage make you feel about Jesus' death?

THURSDAY

Mark 14:60-65

1. Why do you think that Jesus remains silent and does not answer their questions?
2. For what reason is Jesus eventually sentenced to death?
3. Think - In verse 64 the high priest asks "what do you think?". What do you think about Jesus' claim to be the Christ?

FRIDAY

Mark 14:66-72

1. What were the contributing factors that led to Peter's denial of knowing Jesus?
2. How do verses 29, 37, 50 and 54 of this chapter give us a clearer picture of events?
3. Think - What can you learn from Peter's experience that will help you to be prepared for temptation?
