## STUDY 13 – HEB 12:1-29

*They acted entirely on the basis of great faith, sometimes even against common sense or their better judgment.*

2. When will these ‘heroes of faith’ ultimately get what was promised? Why?

*They will get what was promised at the time of judgment. This is because God had planned something better.*



### **Read Hebrews 12**

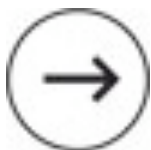
*Note that the majority of this study is quite different to the rest of this series. This study encourages the kids to discover the passage for themselves, and think about how it applies to them in their lives. The best option is to give them time to read through the passage and note down things in the three sections below individually. It is then worthwhile to come back together as a large group and discuss what each person has found.*



**A Light Bulb** → Note down anything that ‘shines’ out to you from the passage. It is whatever impacts you the most, or simply draws your attention.



**A Question Mark** → Note down anything that is difficult to understand in the text, or a question that you would like to ask the writer of the passage.



**An Arrow** → Note down anything that the passage has to say about how what is written may be applied to your life today.
